The GSCI measures competitiveness of countries based on 131 measurable, quantitative indicators derived from reliable sources, such as the World Bank, the IMF, and various UN agencies.

6 Ways to Save our World with Phoebe Barnard


"This should be hundreds of thousands of fires being lit across the planet".
