The Sustainability Accelerator Fellowship aims to empower innovators to launch scalable technology and policy solutions into the real world.



Preparation

Our fellows are empowered to make innovative technological and social change that will measurably improve the quality of human life and our planet. Fellows participate in education and coaching by leaders across disciplines and industries to support their professional growth.

Our fellows share an entrepreneurial spirit and desire to have an impact on the global scale. Fellows learn from and support each other as the next generation of sustainably conscious innovators.

Accelerate

Leveraging the resources of the Sustainability Accelerator and Stanford University, our fellows mature their projects to bring speed and scale to solutions that will benefit the world.

Fellowship terms

Fellows are appointed for a 1 year term with the option to renew for a second year with an annual salary of \$85,000, \$50,000 per year in R&D funds, up to \$2,000 in reimbursable relocation allowances, as well as benefits, including health care coverage.

We seek highly driven problem solvers with a global mindset to tackle our most pressing sustainability challenges. We believe that the most impactful approaches draw on multiple disciplines and perspectives. We strive to build a diverse cohort of fellows that include policymakers, engineers, entrepreneurs, and scientists. Fellows will be funded to work on projects aligned with the Sustainability Accelerator's first Flagship Destination - Greenhouse Gas Removal at the Gigaton Scale by 2050.

Our fellows come from around the world, bring a diversity of experiences, identities, and perspectives, and share a desire to have an impact on the global scale. Applications from all disciplines of science, technology, policy, business, and law are accepted.

Key to the Stanford Sustainability Accelerator Fellowship experience is the community of fellows.
